Post-reading activity 1:

All about the book

Key concepts

Students should begin to:

- understand the problem in *Plant Pest Investigation* and its resolution
- · identify the main characters, and
- recognise key words from the book.

Resources

• Plant Pest Investigation

Lesson steps

- 1. Read the book *Plant Pest Investigation* as a class or in reading groups.
- 2. Discuss with the class or in reading groups what the book was about. What was the 'problem' with Sam's plant and how did the characters solve the problem?
- 3. Complete some of the following activities as a class or in small groups:
 - Read the Sam and Lily pages and discuss the characters. How did they feel when Sam's plant was sick and when they were helping Dr Wheaten?
 - Pest count can you find all the pests hidden in the book? Try to count them all.
 - Crop count can you identify all the crops and crop products in the book? Try to count them all.
 - Make a list of key words from the book
 - Draw a picture of the pest that made Sam's plant sick
 - Complete the Plant Pest Investigation crossword

Further activities:

use some of the key words as spelling words


become a reporter - students prepare a news report about the events in the big book
